Metz is easily reached by major motorways (A4 and A31), high-speed trains (Metz-Ville and Lorraine TGV stations), and the nearby airports of Metz-Nancy, Luxembourg and Saarbrücken. By TGV, you can reach Paris in just 85 minutes, Roissy Charles-de-Gaulle in 71 minutes, and Strasbourg in only 50 minutes.

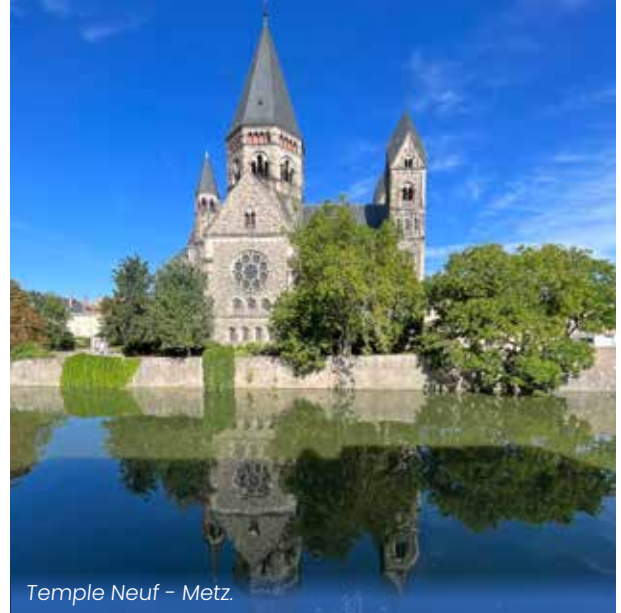

The poet Paul Verlaine was born in Metz on 30 March 1844. Since 2012, the house where he was born has been designated a Maison d'écrivain (writer's house) with the Maison des Illustres label. The first floor is open to visitors. An "In the footsteps of Verlaine" itinerary is also available, offering a tour of the town.

CENTRE POMPIDOU-METZ



Centre for art and culture

The Centre Pompidou-Metz is a unique venue, a surprising architectural masterpiece housing an art centre that stages six to eight temporary exhibitions each year devoted to modern and contemporary art.

Visitors can explore thematic exhibitions drawing on the prestigious collection of the Centre Pompidou in Paris, as well as works from museums, galleries and private collections around the world, alongside monographic exhibitions of internationally renowned artists. With painting, photography, video, architecture, design and live performance, you can also attend shows, lectures and screenings, or simply enjoy a stroll through Gilles Clément's garden.

From 01/04 to 31/10 Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays: 10am–6pm; Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays: 10am–7pm.

From 01/11 to 31/03 Mondays and Wednesdays to Sundays: 10am–6pm – Closed Tuesdays and 1 May.

THE TREASURES OF THE COUR D'OR

The Musée de la Cour d'Or-Metz Eurometropole showcases the richness of Metz's heritage. It houses the remains of Gallo-Roman baths and the famous Chèvremont granary, and has an exceptional ensemble of reconstructed medieval architecture, including the chancel of Saint-Pierre-aux-Nonnains. Visitors can also admire superb medieval painted wooden ceilings, as well as a Fine Arts section and a Biodiversity Pavilion. Open daily except Tuesdays, from 10am to 12.45pm and from 2pm to 6pm.

49 NORD 6 EST – FRAC LORRAINE

The 49 Nord 6 Est – Frac Lorraine exhibition space hosts exhibitions as well as debates, conferences, film screenings, concerts and performances. Its collection of over 1,800 works focuses on the role of women in the arts. It is housed in Metz's oldest private mansion, the Hôtel Saint-Livier, a 13th-century civil building.

METZ – CITY TOUR

An important Gallo-Roman city, capital of the Merovingian Kingdom of Austrasia, cradle of the Carolingian kings, opulent medieval city, and capital of the province of the Three Bishopsrics, Metz boasts exceptional architectural and monumental ensembles. From Saint-Étienne's Cathedral to the old citadel district, passing through Place de la Comédie, visitors can soak in the city's glorious past, and emblems of urban planning and contemporary art. If you are travelling by coach, the tour can continue as far as the Imperial Quarter and the forecourt of the Centre Pompidou-Metz.

THE LANTERN OF GOD

Built between 1220 and 1522, Saint-Étienne's Cathedral dominates the city and showcases magnificent stained glass from the 13th to the 21st century, created by renowned artists, including Chagall. Not to be missed!

Remarkable: one of France's tallest and most light-filled naves.

Variant: the Fantastic Cathedral: gargoyles, mythical creatures, and fabulous monsters recall ancient times steeped in legendary beliefs.

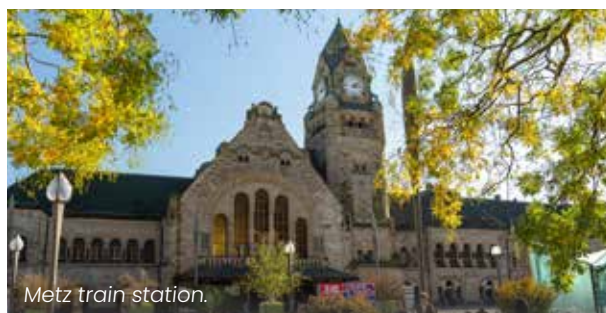

FROM THE LANTERN OF GOD TO THE IMPERIAL TRAIN STATION

A walking route from Saint-Étienne's Cathedral to the Imperial Train Station, passing through Place Saint-Louis and the Imperial Quarter, showcasing a variety of architectural styles.

IMPERIAL QUARTER

A remarkable example of early 20th-century German urban planning, the Imperial Quarter blends historical and modern styles: Neo-Romanesque, Neo-Gothic, Neo-Renaissance, and Jugendstil.

The station, the centrepiece of the district, was voted "France's most beautiful station" three times by internet users. Its size (300 metres long) and Neo-Romanesque style are truly striking.

OUTRE-SEILLE AND PORTE DES ALLEMANDS

A guided tour of the Outre-Seille district, home to the medieval churches of Saint-Eucaire and Saint-Maximin (the latter boasts remarkable stained-glass windows designed by Jean Cocteau). The Porte des Allemands (13th-16th centuries) is a rare example in France of a fortified bridge, and the only remaining gate of the original 18 gates of Metz's medieval walls. A small fortified castle, emblematic of the city, this example of Metz's military architecture offers unique views over the Seille and the surrounding gardens.

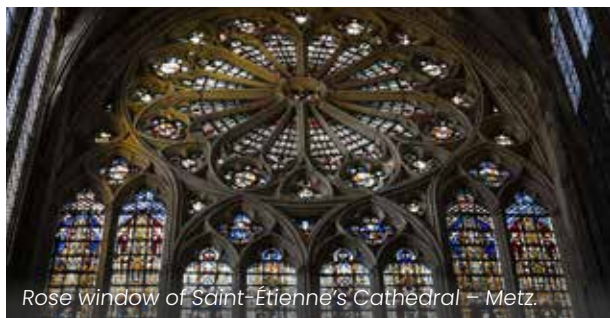

The art of light par excellence, stained glass can be found in all of Metz's religious buildings. This tour features stained glass windows from the medieval period to more contemporary creations, including the windows of Saint-Étienne's Cathedral and those designed by Jean Cocteau in Saint-Maximin's church.

MEDIEVAL AND RENAISSANCE METZ

The Sainte-Croix hill, the historic heart of the city, has retained its medieval character, with winding streets, small squares and townhouses. The walk takes you past the Musée de la Cour d'Or – Metz Eurometropole, the Hôtel Saint-Livier, the Recollets Cloister – Centre for Urban Ecology, and the remains of the house where Rabelais stayed, finishing at the Place Saint-Louis to admire Italian-influenced medieval architecture. This tour includes the cathedral.

METZ GARDENS

In the heart of the city, on the Sainte-Croix Hill, discover the Mediterranean-inspired Jardin des Tanneurs, and the splendid 13th-century Cloître des Récollets, now home to the European Institute of Ecology and the municipal archives, as well as a medicinal plant garden. The expansive French-style Esplanade Garden in the old citadel district offers elegant statues and harmonious fountains just a stone's throw from the city's shopping streets.

Optional: with your coach, continue to the Botanical Gardens, a landscaped 10-acre park created in 1866, or take a boat ride on the Moselle.

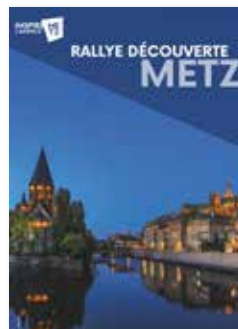

These general terms and conditions of sale are provided together with the quotation prior to concluding the booking contract. In accordance with European Directive (EU) 2015/2302 and Article L211 of the French Tourism Code, Inspire Metz shall also provide the "Information Form for Package Travel Contracts".

ARTICLE 1: LEGAL PROVISIONS

Authorised Tourist Offices, under the French Tourism Code, may book and sell all types of leisure and hospitality services of public interest within their operational area. They facilitate public access by offering a selection of services. Under no circumstances may ADN Tourisme or the Tourist Offices be held liable for any use of these contracts by third parties or for non-tourism-related purposes. Booking any service through Inspire Metz implies acceptance of these terms and conditions.

ARTICLE 2: LIABILITY

Inspire Metz is the sole point of contact for the client and is responsible for fulfilling the obligations outlined in these terms of sale. Inspire Metz cannot be held responsible for cases of force majeure or for the actions of any individuals unrelated to the organisation and operation of the service. Inspire Metz reserves the right to choose its service partners.

ARTICLE 3: BOOKING AND PAYMENT TERMS

3.1 Booking conditions

– Packages with accommodation: a booking is confirmed once a 30% deposit and a signed copy of the contract (marked "Agreed" or "Bon pour Accord" by the client) are returned to Inspire Metz by the deadline stated in the quotation.

– For individual **"METZ EXTRA"** packages and late bookings, full payment will be required.

Excursion without accommodation: a booking is confirmed once a 30% deposit and a signed copy of the contract (marked "Agreed" or "Bon pour Accord" by the client) are returned to Inspire Metz by the deadline stated in the quotation. By placing an order, the client implicitly acknowledges having received all necessary information regarding the nature and features of the services booked.

3.2 Balance Payment

Packages with accommodation: the balance must be paid no later than 10 days before the start of the service. Once paid, Inspire Metz will issue the final invoice and email the client a voucher to present to the service providers.

Excursion without accommodation: the balance must be paid no later than 10 days before the start of the service. Once paid, Inspire Metz will issue the final invoice and email the client a voucher to present to the service providers.

– **Guided tours (with no extras)**: payment must be made no later than 10 days before the date of the tour. Once paid, Inspire Metz will issue the final invoice. Unpaid bookings 72 hours before the tour, without further client communication, will be cancelled without notice.

No-shows or cancellations within 4 days will incur 100% charges.

– **Tourist train bookings**: payment must be made at least 10 days before the tour date. Once paid, Inspire Metz will issue the invoice.

Unpaid bookings 72 hours before the tour, without further client communication, will be cancelled without notice.

Upon payment of the balance of the invoice, Agence Inspire Metz will send the customer a voucher to be presented to the train driver.

No-shows or cancellations within 72 hours of the tour will incur 100% charges.

3.3 Late bookings

Bookings made less than 30 days before the start of the service require full payment at the time of booking.

ARTICLE 4: VOUCHERS

Upon full payment, Inspire Metz will email the client a voucher, to be presented to the service provider upon arrival.

ARTICLE 5: ARRIVAL

Clients must arrive at the specified location on the date and time specified in the contract. In delayed or unable to attend, they must undertake to inform Inspire Metz.

ARTICLE 6: CONTRACT CHANGES

6.1 By the client:

The contract is based on a specific number of participants. Any change to this number may result in contract modification or cancellation.

Changes to the itinerary are not permitted without prior agreement from Inspire Metz. All services will be charged based on the number of participants initially confirmed.

EXCURSIONS (WITHOUT ACCOMMODATION)

Cancellations made at least 10 full days before the start of the service may be accepted, subject to provider approval and except in special cases:

In the event of partial cancellation of one or more members, tickets for the Centre Pompidou-Metz are non-refundable and non-exchangeable once the invoice has been issued. The full amount of the ticket booking will remain payable.

Cancellations made less than 10 full days before the start of the service will be subject to the cancellation fees set out in Article 8.

Any changes to the contract once signed will incur cancellation charges as set out in Article 8. Any postponement of the date will be treated as a cancellation and will be subject to fees, as set out in Article 8.

An administration fee of €10 per file will be invoiced for changes made more than 30 days prior to departure, and €15 per file for changes within 30 days.

6.2 By Inspire Metz:

If, before the scheduled start of the service, Inspire Metz is required to make a change to a key element of the contract, the client may, without prejudice to any claims for compensation for any damage suffered, and after being informed by Inspire Metz by any means:

– either cancel the contract and receive an immediate refund of all payments made, without penalty

– or accept the proposed changes or substituted services, with an amendment to the contract signed by both parties.

If the substitute service is less expensive than the original, the difference will be refunded to the client before the service begins.

ARTICLE 7 – INABILITY OF INSPIRE METZ TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES STIPULATED IN THE CONTRACT DURING THE COURSE OF THE SERVICE

If, during the course of the outing or stay, Inspire Metz is unable to provide a substantial portion of the contracted services, representing a significant percentage of the total price paid by the client, Inspire Metz – without prejudice to any claims for compensation for damages suffered – will offer a replacement service at no additional cost. If the replacement service is of a lower standard, the client will be refunded the difference in price.

If no replacement can be offered, or if the client reasonably refuses the proposed alternative, Inspire Metz will refund the proportion of the total price corresponding to the services not delivered.

ARTICLE 8: TOTAL OR PARTIAL CANCELLATION

8.1 By the client:

Changes to or cancellation of a stay/outing made by the customer

Any modification or cancellation of the trip – whether total or partial withdrawal (such as the absence of one or more participants, or changes to the travel dates) must be made in writing. Only the date of receipt of the written request will be taken into account when applying cancellation fees. Any request received on a Sunday, public holiday, or after 5pm will only be processed on the next working day.

Total or partial cancellation (except in special cases): Total cancellation refers to complete withdrawal from the trip after the contract has been signed.

Partial cancellation refers to any change made after the contract has been signed and that results in: – A reduction in the number of participants, – Reduction in the duration of the stay, – Cancellation of certain services, – Any modification resulting in a decrease in the total cost of the booking.

Any total or partial cancellation will incur the following charges:

– All cancellation requests must be sent by registered post to Inspire Metz. In the event of total or partial cancellation by the client, the amount reimbursed to the client by Inspire Metz, with the exception of any administrative fees charged at the time of booking, will be as follows:

– Cancellation more than 30 days before the start of the service: 10% of the cost of the total booking cost will be retained;

– Cancellation between 30 and 21 days (inclusive) before the start of the service: 25% of the price of the total booking will be retained;

– Cancellation between 20 and 8 days (inclusive) before the start of the service: 50% of the cost of the total booking cost will be retained;

– Cancellation between 7 and 3 days (inclusive) before the start of the service: 75% of the cost of the total booking cost will be retained;

– Cancellation less than 2 days before the start of the service: 100% of the total booking cost will be charged. In the event of a no-show, no refund will be issued.

8.2 By Inspire Metz:

If Inspire Metz cancels the service before it begins, the client will be informed by any available means.

The client will receive a full refund of all payments made, without prejudice to any claims for damages. Additionally, the client will be compensated with an amount at least equal to the cancellation fee they would have incurred had they cancelled on that date.

These provisions do not apply if a mutual agreement is reached whereby the client accepts a substitute service offered by Inspire Metz.

8.3 Specific Conditions for Centre Pompidou-Metz:

- Tickets issued cannot be exchanged or refunded, except in the event of cancellation by Centre Pompidou-Metz. Associated ticketing fees are non-refundable.

- Tickets for booking a guide at the Centre Pompidou-Metz must be issued no later than 60 days before the visit. These tickets are non-refundable and cannot be changed.

ARTICLE 9: DELAYS

For services including a guided tour, the guide will wait for a maximum of 30 minutes. The tour will be shortened proportionally to the length of the delay. However, if the group extends the tour beyond the scheduled time – with the guide's agreement and subject to their availability – additional charges for overtime will apply.

Once the 30-minute waiting time has elapsed, if no communication has been received from the group, the guide will be released and the full cost of the tour will be due.

ARTICLE 10: PRICES AND PAYMENT METHODS

Prices from Inspire Metz include VAT applicable on the date of the booking request. Group rates are based on the specific request and are detailed in a quote, which will constitute the special terms and conditions of sale. Economic fluctuations may lead to changes in prices and services.

Accepted payment methods:

- cash;
- bank cheque (excluding non-crossed cheques) made out to Agence Inspire Metz;
- holiday vouchers;
- bank card (in person or remotely);
- bank transfer;
- purchase orders accepted for secondary schools, colleges and French public institutions.

Bank charges related to invoice and deposit payments are the responsibility of the client.

ARTICLE 11: INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE

In the event of interruption of the service by the client, no refund will be issued.

ARTICLE 12: INSURANCE

The client is liable for any damage caused by them and is advised to take out third-party liability insurance.

ARTICLE 13: HOTELS

- Prices include bed and breakfast, half-board, or full-board, depending on the option selected. Unless otherwise stated, drinks and extras are not included.
- If a client occupies a double room alone, a single room supplement will be charged.
- Local tourist tax is payable directly to the accommodation provider by the client.

ARTICLE 14: OTHER SERVICES

- Fixed compensation for recovery costs: any business client still to pay an invoice after the due date must pay a fixed recovery fee of €40 (not subject to VAT), applicable to transactions under the French Commercial Code.

ARTICLE 16: DATA PROTECTION

- Personal data provided by clients is processed by Inspire Metz's Visitor Services team, the data controller, for the purpose of organising guided tours, half-day packages, and packages with or without accommodation.

- Data is stored in a customer relationship management database and retained for 5 years after the end of the commercial relationship. Data required to establish proof of a right or contract, or retained for the purposes of legal compliance, may be stored for a longer period and archived according to applicable laws (e.g. the French Commercial Code, Civil Code or Consumer Code).

- The information collected is not shared with third parties other than the services providers involved in the services booked.

- In accordance with the French Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978, amended on 7 October 2016, and the General Data Protection Regulation of 25 May 2018, clients have the right to access, rectify, object to, limit processing, delete, and transfer the data they have provided to Inspire Metz. INFORMATION FORM FOR PACKAGE TRAVEL CONTRACTS – INSPIRE METZ AGENCY

The combination of travel services offered constitutes a package under Directive (EU) 2015/2302 and Article L211 of the French Tourism Code.

You are therefore entitled to all EU rights applicable to package travel. Inspire Metz is fully responsible for the proper execution of the package.

Additionally, as required by law, Inspire Metz has protection in place to refund your payments and, if transport is included, to ensure repatriation in case of insolvency. Key Rights under Directive (EU) 2015/2302 transposed into the French Tourism Code: Travellers will receive all essential information about the package before signing the contract.

The organiser and retailer are responsible for the proper delivery of all travel services included in the contract.

Travellers will be provided with a contact number or point of contact for assistance. Travellers may transfer the package to another person with reasonable notice and possibly additional fees.

The package price may only increase due to specific cost increases (e.g. fuel prices), if stated in the contract, and not within 20 days of the start date. If the increase exceeds 8% of the total package price, the traveller may cancel the contract. If the organiser reserves the right to increase the price, the traveller is also entitled to a price reduction if the relevant costs go down.

Travellers may cancel the contract without penalty and receive a full refund if a key element of the package (other than price) is significantly changed. If the organiser cancels the package before it begins, travellers are entitled to a refund and possibly compensation.

Travellers may cancel without penalty before the package starts in exceptional circumstances (e.g. serious safety issues at the destination that are likely to affect the package).

In addition, travellers may cancel at any time before the package starts by paying appropriate and justifiable cancellation fees.

If the organiser or retailer becomes insolvent, payments will be refunded. If, after the start of the package, significant elements of the package cannot be provided as agreed, suitable alternative arrangements will have to be offered to the traveller at no extra cost.
